Our Community and Consumer Voice Committee led an 8-month process to develop a shared

RESULTS



Healthier Here received a perfect score from Washington State on our Implementation Plan and our first Semi-Annual Report, earning an additional **\$23 million** to invest in our collaborative efforts

INNOVATION

We developed an innovative Investment Prioritization Tool to objectively focus decision-making.



The tool helped to identify where we should initially focus in 2019 and which clinical investments were most aligned with our values and performance metrics.

We engaged with community groups, coalitions and organizations through webinars, information sessions and presentations at **15 different locations**.

As a result, **99 CBOs** submitted forms indicating their interest in participating in the selection process to become a 2019 Community Practice Partner.

PARTNERSHIP



We brought together individuals and organizations from different sectors and encouraged them to work together in new ways.

Cross-Sector Work Groups – Individuals from 40+ organizations teamed up to brainstorm strategies and provide input to our Implementation Plan.

Partner Learning Webinar Series – In this ongoing educational series, experts from local organizations share their knowledge and experience on specific topics.

Clinical Practice Partner Learning Collaboratives – We held the first of a series of forums designed to foster connection and shared problem solving.

HealthierHere Committees – These cross-sector groups met regularly and provided direction and oversight on equity and consumer engagement, finance, implementation, and performance measurement.

We delivered incentive payments of ~ \$6.0 million to qualified Medicaid providers for planning and engagement activities; and \$4.3 million to our Behavioral Health partners to support transitioning to Integrated Managed Care.
