Connect people within their communities

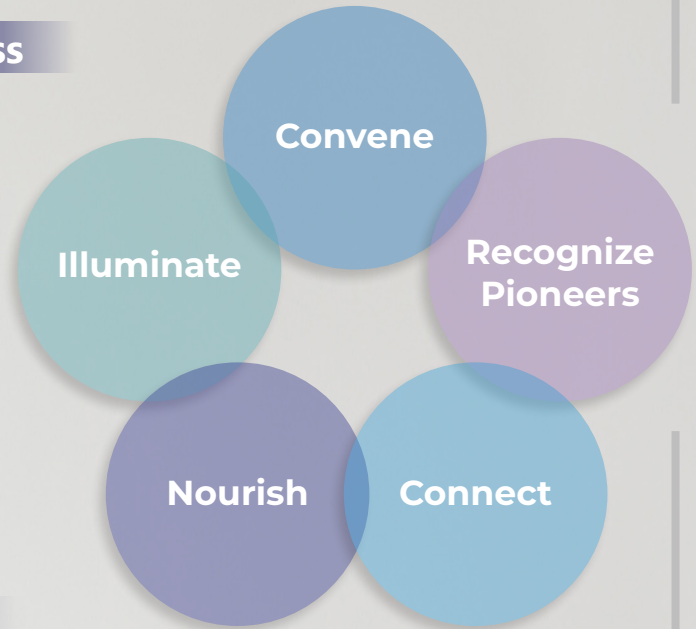
